



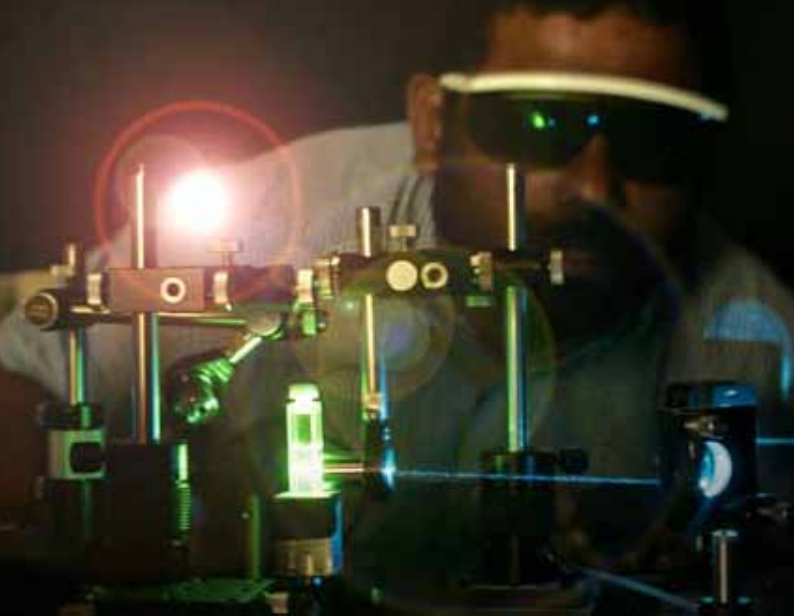
# DID YOU KNOW

IRL is one of the first organisations to be accredited to provide R&D support to businesses under the new Technology Transfer Voucher funding scheme.



The government-funded programme is designed to build better linkages between research organisations and businesses and increase the transfer of technology and knowledge between the two.

Businesses in the high-value manufacturing and services sector that have limited in-house R&D capability are the first target. They will be eligible for a voucher, worth at least \$30,000, to purchase research services and expertise from approved providers like IRL, who can also help with the application process.
